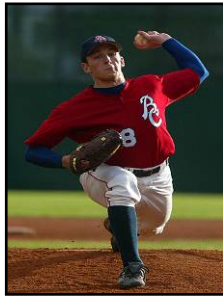


### National Coaching Institute – BC
